How much \$ to bring?	ALL expenses are paid, including transportation, lodging, and meals. Students will be given a cash “per diem” to cover meals not provided at the conference. Additional spending money for free time (there’s not much!), shopping, and incidentals is the responsibility of the student/parent.
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<p>What to pack?</p>	<p>Packing: There will be 11 or 12 people riding in the van, so it will be FULL! Please pack as lightly as possible!</p> <p>There IS a pool at the hotel and workout/fitness facility at the hotel.</p>
	<p>Clothes: The attire for MOST the conference is “business professional.” The conference coincides with the AK Teacher Placement Job Fair, so you will be surrounded by teachers, principals, superintendents, etc., who will be dressed for interviews and highly professional (and competitive) interactions. Appropriate attire includes nice slacks, skirts, dresses, etc. Boys will definitely want at least one shirt/tie combo with nice slacks. The OPENING CEREMONY on Thursday evening and the UAA events on Saturday are “business casual”... meaning comfortable but NICE clothing. Jeans are o.k. for these events, but they should be “nice” (no holes, stains, etc.). No hoodies, sweatshirts, t-shirts with logos, etc. Events ALL DAY on Friday and Saturday afternoon are “business professional” – NO jeans at all at these events! The banquet on Saturday evening will be a semi-formal event.</p>
	<p>“Free Time” and evening attire: There will be a bit of downtime in the evenings at the hotel, with time to visit with new friends from across the state and relax. When you are out of your room in the hotel, you MUST be dressed “appropriately”! Keep in mind that the Job Fair is also going on, so...if your pj’s include a tiny little cami top with short-shorts, you will need something else to wear (such as a t-shirt, sweatpants, etc.), when you are in the hotel’s public/common areas. Students must be appropriately dressed whenever they are out of their hotel rooms!</p>
